UK GAAP v IFRS	Many businesses are converting from UK GAAP to IFRS. Many accountants are trained in IFRS but use UK GAAP. We examine the main differences between the two systems.
Annual tax update	A must for all accountants. It's a round up of all the main changes to all the main taxes.
