

Student Webinar – 08.04.20

AAT:

- All exams have been suspended. We are currently awaiting news on their plans for the coming months.
- The next possible synoptic windows will be 22nd June for the Advanced level and 29th June for Professional level if the current windows do not run.

ACCA:

- June sittings of skills and professional exams have been cancelled. Exams that had already been booked will be refunded. However, students will not be automatically be rebooked onto the September sitting.
- Exams slots are available for the September sittings and can be booked by contacting the ACCA directly.
- The ACCA are evaluating on-demand F-level exams to establish whether these can be sat at home via remote proctoring.
- We are currently running Virtual Classroom tuition courses for the September sittings and are re-working classroom revision course dates to be held in August.
- The ACCA advise students to look at paper combinations that go together in order to sit more than one exam in September. For example, Financial Reporting and Audit & Assurance.
- Those studying under the June syllabus will be able to sit to the September sitting. There are minimal changes to material despite the syllabus update.
- ACCA have also confirmed they will not be updating the tax units until next year.

CIMA:

- An email has gone out to students confirming exams can be sat at home using remote invigilation and will be available to sit from the 4th May. Students should be able to book the exams a couple of weeks before then.
- Case Study exams will be available to sit online from late May. CIMA are due to announce more information w/c 13th April regarding when these will be available.
- CIMA certificate exams will also go ahead from May. We will offer support and provide extra mocks and questions. Contact your local FI centre for more information.
- Case study preseen material will not change from the May to the August sitting.

ICAEW:

- The June Professional Level exams are cancelled. The next exams to go ahead are expected to be 7th -11th September. These should be available to book from 29th June.
- All Advanced Level exams have been deferred to 24, 25, 26th August
- FRC have given approval for certificate exams to be run remotely. The ICAEW are hoping these exams will be available in May.
