## **Credit and Debt Management: Summary of corrections to course materials**

These changes affect version V001 of the materials.

The claim values for determining how to bring a dispute to court have been updated as follows:

- The **small claims track** is for debts of **£10,000** or less. (This used to be referred to as "the small claims court" but this was confusing as it implied a separate court, when it is in fact just a process within the County Court.)
- The **fast track** is for debts between **£10,000** and **£25,000**, where the case is likely to take **no** more than one day in court.
- The multi-track is for cases which will take more than one day in court and debts over £25,000. Complex cases of less than £25,000 will also be dealt with via the multi-track.
