The Programme

The entry requirements will be set by the employer and therefore may vary. You will typically need five GCSEs grade 4-9 (old system A*-C).

You may be required to take functional skills maths and/or English at level 2, if you do not hold at least the equivalent qualification GCSE grade 4 or C and are under 19 years old.

The roles associated with this apprenticeship can be varied but must cover the occupational duties within the standard:

- Assistant auditor
- Assistant management accountant/ financial accountant
- Accounts payable and expenses supervisor
- Commercial analyst

The Level 7 Professional Accountant Apprenticeship offers the opportunity to become a qualified accountant via an apprenticeship programme.



End Point Assessment

The end-point assessment is the final showcase of competency for the apprentice across all the knowledge, skills and behaviours defined in the apprenticeship standards.

Synoptic Assessment

A role simulation synoptic exam questions.

The end-point assessment will be graded with apprentices able to achieve either a pass or distinction.

Professional Discussion

A professional discussion with two independent assessors from the assessment organisation, to demonstrate and evidence the knowledge, skills and behaviours.

Duration

The duration of the Level 4 Professional Accounting Technician Apprenticeship will typically be 18 - 24 months.

The minimum duration on programme before an apprentice can take the end-point assessment is 12 months.
