ICAEW is an England and Wales professional membership organisation that promotes, develops and supports chartered accountants and students nationally.

The first 6 papers (certificate level) are on-demand exams which means that you can sit the exams when you are ready.

The 6 professional papers we teach towards sittings in June and December. They have scheduled exam dates and must be booked via ICAEW. The exams will be sat at a centre that is provided by ICAEW.

The final 3 advanced stage papers can be sat together or individually at sittings in July and November. Again, these exams will be sat at a centre that is provided by the ICAFW.

Why choose the extended study path?

During the standard study path, students will study the Certificate Level within an a shorter period, however, this isn't always the best way to study. Below, we cover the reasons a longer programme length can be better suited for students.

Fully Embedded Knowledge

It allows for the knowledge to be fully embedded before moving onto the professional level papers where it will be built upon further. The longer programme also provides students time to apply the knowledge in the workplace.

More Structured Time

This path is ideal for school leavers or non-relevant graduates who would require more time to fully cover all the worked lecture examples and benefit from structured question practice.

Better Suited than AAT

ICAEW CFAB better prepares students for the full ICAEW (level 7) qualification, there is a natural progression compared to doing AAT. There is also the added value of quicker exam result turnaround time compared to AAT.

Allows for Catch Up Time

CFAB is a challenging qualification. The longer programme allows more time to consolidate knowledge between phases and provides flexibility if a student were to fall behind.

Our ICAEW CFAB Level 4 Accounting Technician apprenticeship programme builds the foundations for future development in the world of accountancy. The programme will help you to develop all the skills you will need to work in a modern environment.

In addition to this, our level 4 qualification will equip you with all the necessary technical knowledge by embedding the ICAEW CFAB professional qualification as part of the apprenticeship programme.

Employer Information

The Level 4 accounting apprenticeship with ICAEW combines work experience and the ICAEW Certificate in Finance, Accounting and Business (ICAEW CFAB) - a nationally recognised stand-alone qualification, which also makes up the Certificate Level of the ACA. Throughout the programme apprentices develop the skills, knowledge and behaviours required by the standard and which are essential for a career in accountancy.

The funding cap for the Level 4 accountancy apprenticeship for accountancy professionals has been set at £8,000. This can be funded via the apprenticeship levy for levy-paying employers. Non-levy paying employers can be funded 5% contribution and the government will pay the remaining 95%. ACA student fee and exam fees are not included.

Entry Requirements



There are no set entry requirements but you must have GCSEs in English and Maths (grades A-C/9-4) or equivalent by the time you sit the end-point assessment.

Employers may also set their own criteria.

Qualification Level



The Level 4 apprenticeships are equivalent to a foundation degree.

To be accepted, you should have a level 3 qualification. This includes A-levels, or have completed a level 3 apprenticeship.





ICAEW Apprenticeship

Professional Accountant Apprenticeship (Level 7)



Equivalent to a Master's degree, the Level 7 apprenticeship offers a programme which will develop business leaders of the future. The programme aligns with globally recognised professional accountancy ICAEW qualification, as well as providing structured support and guidance for each apprentice's wider development.

The duration of the Level 7 Accounting and Taxation Professional Apprenticeship will typically be 36 months. The minimum duration on programme before an apprentice can take the end-point assessment is 12 months. Please note, funding is only available to those 21 and under from January 2026.

Employer Information

The Level 7 Accountancy Apprenticeship is a perfect opportunity for employers to offer the ACA on a government-funded programme. Combining work experience and the ACA - the globally recognised ICEAW qualification, this apprenticeship sets students well on their way to becoming a chartered accountant. Throughout the programme apprentices develop the skills, knowledge and behaviours required by the standard and which are essential for a career in accountancy.

Funding is only available to those 21 and under from January 2026. The funding cap for the Level 7 Accountancy Apprenticeship for Accountancy Professionals has been set at £21,000. This can be funded via the apprenticeship levy for levy-paying employers. Non-levy paying employers can be funded 5% contribution and the government will pay the remaining 95%. ACA student fee and exam fees are not included.
